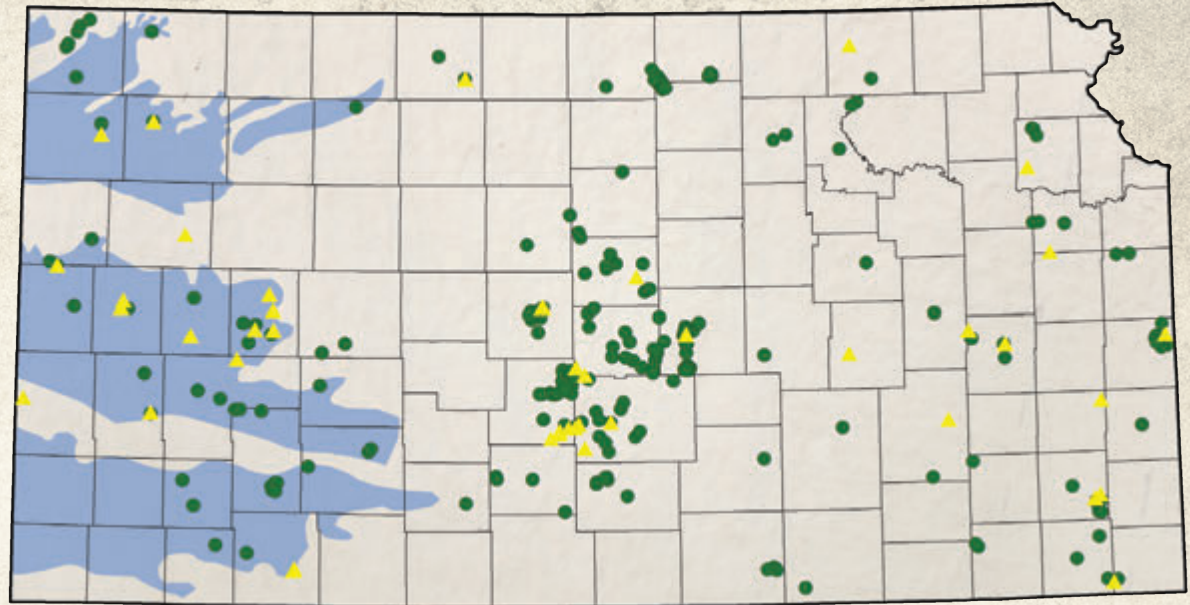

EXAMPLES OF RECENT PROJECTS

CLINTON WILDLIFE AREA

Restoration of 145 acres of wetland habitat above Clinton Lake enhances the ability of the area to clean water of excess sediments and nutrients before entering the lake. Through funding provided by the City of Lawrence to target water quality improvements, DU was able to partner with the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism and the Kansas Alliance for Wetlands and Streams to complete this restoration which benefits water quality, wildlife and the public.

On average, a 10-acre wetland can remove 40% of excess fertilizer nitrogen from 1,000 acres of cropland and trap 10 dump truck loads (135 tons) of sediment annually before it enters rivers or reservoirs.

NINNESCAH RIVER CONSERVATION EASEMENT

DU used a donated conservation easement and North American Wetlands Conservation Act funding on private land to permanently protect a 375-acre tract of grassland and riparian habitat, as well as restore 15 acres of wetlands. These wetland acres will slow the flow of water from surrounding agriculture fields into the North Fork of the Ninnescah River.

Each acre of wetland can hold 325,000 gallons of water helping to reduce the magnitude of local and downstream flooding.

STAFFORD PRAIRIE RESTORATION

DU assisted in delivering a Wetlands Reserve Easement in partnership with the Natural Resources Conservation Service to protect and convert 78 acres of marginal cropland to tall grass prairie. Additionally, 20 acres of wetlands will be restored by removing excess sediment and adding an upland buffer of native grass.

Converting these 78 acres of cropland to perennial grassland will annually remove as much carbon dioxide (375 tons) as 70 cars could emit in a year.



KANSAS WATER INITIATIVE

For generations, landowners and residents of the Sunflower State have struggled to navigate situations related to too much, not enough, or unclear water concerns. The Kansas Water Initiative (KWI) is a new Ducks Unlimited (DU) habitat delivery and fundraising opportunity that aims to alleviate several of the water-related issues facing Kansas today.

The KWI focuses on more than just waterfowl habitat. These projects will improve water quality and quantity, mitigate floods, and deliver win-win scenarios for farmers, ranchers, and other landowners across the state. What's more, the program aims to deliver custom solutions because water needs vary so much across Kansas.

Like so many of Ducks Unlimited's undertakings, the KWI attempts to do a lot with little funding or resources. Thankfully, there are ways you can help. If you or your organization is interested in learning more, please contact one of the DU representatives listed below.

Kansas Ducks Unlimited 2023 Calendar Rules

- Persons under the age of 18 may not purchase a Calendar or win a firearm.
- Calendars are \$50.00, or \$55 if purchased online and limited to 2000 calendars.
- Each Calendar constitutes an equal chance to win.
- Cash, personal checks and credit cards are accepted for the sale of the Calendar. Firearms will not be awarded until the check clears the bank. Checks returned NSF are subject to additional fee and disqualification.
- Winners need not be present to win. Winning Calendars will be drawn using a computerized Random Numbers Generating Program. Each Calendar will have an equal chance of being drawn for every firearm.
- All winners and additional info will be posted on the official calendar website weekly:

- Winners will be notified (email/phone) with instruction as to how to claim your firearm.
- The winning calendar for each gun receives the firearm printed on the calendar for that day.
- No firearms will be awarded until Calendars & money have been accounted for by Ducks Unlimited.
- All firearm regulations must be met before you can receive a firearm.
- All firearm winners are responsible for any fees (shipping(\$25), FFL transfer, taxes, etc.).
- All firearms must be claimed within thirty (30) days after the notification is made. After 30 days, all unclaimed firearms become property of Ducks Unlimited.
- Ducks Unlimited reserves the right to modify any firearm if needed based on manufacturer's available inventory.
- Weekly pictures of the firearms may vary slightly from actual firearm.
- Ducks Unlimited, Inc., is a 501(c)(3) charity and your contribution may be deductible for income tax purposes. Please see your tax advisor for actual deductibility.
- \$1.25 of your annual membership will be applied to your one-year subscription of Ducks Unlimited Magazine beginning January 1st 2023 and is non-deductible from your annual membership dues.
