Suffolk Ducks Unlimited Croaker Classic & Crab Feast 2024 Rules and Regulations

1. No participant is to have a baited line in the water before 12:01 A.M. or after 1:30 P.M. on August 24, 2024; THIS MEANS YOU CAN START FISHING JUST AFTER MIDNIGHT IF YOU WANT TO, BUT YOU DO NOT HAVE TO START AT THAT TIME.
2. The down-river tournament boundary will be the CHESAPEAKE BAY BRIDGE TUNNEL. Boats may fish as far upriver as they please.
3. Weigh in opens at 1:30 p.m. and closes at 2:30 p.m. Any team not in the weigh line by 2:30 p.m. will be disqualified.
4. Each team will determine their 3 heaviest croaker fish and submit them to the Weigh Master (KEVIN NEAL) for final weight. Teams may only weigh once, and the Weigh Master's records are final.
5. The Weigh Master will be located at the Nansemond River Duck Club. Fish will be inspected at weigh in and shall be kept in good, fresh, and edible condition by the participants. Any fish that appears to be mutilated or decayed will be disqualified.
6. Fish are to be taken by hook and line only.
7. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any person.
8. This is a Rain or Shine event that will raise money for wetland conservation.
9. Fisherman will fish at their own discretion and accept full responsibility for their vessel and crew, and compliance with applicable laws and regulations regarding fishing licenses, vessel permits, fishing gear, season size limits, and bag limits. For purpose of safety, all boats must adhere to all US Coast Guard and VMRC regulations. Participants shall also adhere to all Tournament rules as contained herein.
10. The Tournament Committee will hear any protests in private. Decisions of the Tournament Committee will be made by the Tournament Committee in their sole and absolute discretion. All decisions by the Tournament Committee are final and are not subject to further challenge by participants in any way.
11. Sportsmanship, courtesy, safety, and conservation are expected from every fisherman.
