*Alaska has 14 NAWCA projects either completed or underway. These projects have conserved 64,892 acres of wildlife habitat. NAWCA funding of over \$4.6 million stimulated partner contributions of more than \$13.6 million.*

## GOOSE BAY WATERSHED PROTECTION PROJECT

This project aims to purchase and protect 286 acres of coastal wetlands within Goose Bay State Game Refuge, helping to ensure the protection of sensitive coastal wetlands, important bird habitat and an anadromous fish stream in the refuge boundaries.

The Conservation Fund will purchase the tract and convey the land to the Alaska Department of Fish and Game for inclusion in the refuge, created to ensure the protection of fish and wildlife populations, particularly waterfowl nesting, feeding, and migration habitats; moose calving areas; spring and fall bear feeding areas; and salmon spawning and rearing habitats. It was also established for wildlife-dependent public use, particularly waterfowl, moose and bear hunting and wildlife viewing and photography.
