## CRENSHAW WETLAND ENHANCEMENT / RESTORATION PROJECT - SLOUGHS WMA

Sloughs

WMA is an important wetland and waterfowl complex consisting of approximately 11,100 acres of Ohio River floodplain that is open to annual flooding. The area is bordered on the west side of the Ohio River by the 7,400-acre Hovey Lake Fish and Wildlife Area (FWA) in southwest Indiana. Sloughs and Hovey Lake together are recognized as high priority areas for waterfowl, shorebirds and other wetland dependent waterbirds.

The Crenshaw Wetland Enhancement/Restoration Project will provide 109 acres of managed water in six pools on the Sauerheber Unit of Sloughs Wildlife Management Area (WMA). The project will enhance 22 acres of existing habitat and restore seasonal hydrology on another 87 acres of open lands along the west side of the Sauerheber Unit, more specifically known as the Crenshaw Tract. Benefitted species include mallards, Canada geese, snow geese and white-fronted geese.
