TOTAL ACRES

Massachusetts has 48 NAWCA projects either completed or underway. These projects have conserved 9,581 acres of wildlife habitat. NAWCA funding of more than \$16 million stimulated partner contributions of over \$53.4 million. These figures do not include multi-state projects.

PARKER RIVER & RACHEL CARSON NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGES

This project will permanently protect 33 acres of tidal salt marsh habitat as part of Parker River NWR, restore 14 acres of tidal salt marsh habitat on Parker River NWR and 20 acres on Rachel Carson NWR. Protected and restored areas will provide foraging, migration and wintering habitat for a variety of waterfowl species such as the American black duck, northern pintail, mallard, gadwall, Atlantic brant, Canada geese and American wigeon. The coastal marshes in both areas are used extensively by American black duck during migration and for overwintering.
