Michigan has 53 NAWCA projects either completed or underway. These projects have conserved 60,723 acres of wildlife habitat. NAWCA funding of more than \$20 million stimulated partner contributions of over \$66.5 million. These figures do not include multi-state projects.

SAGINAW BAY TO LAKE ERIE COASTAL HABITAT PROJECT PHASE III

Phase III of the Saginaw Bay to Lake Erie Coastal Habitat Project focuses on coastal zones associated with Saginaw Bay and western Lake Erie. Begun in 2005, the project envisioned linking wetlands and adjacent grasslands to restore habitat lost through development and optimize remaining habitat to compensate for those wild places permanently lost. More than three million waterfowl annually migrate through or breed in the Great Lakes region. Many of them depend on the corridor of fragmented habitat that extends from Saginaw Bay to western Lake Erie, including Lake St. Clair and the Detroit River. The corridor has vital breeding habitat for mallards and wood ducks, as well as smaller breeding populations of American black ducks, redheads, shovelers and blue-winged teal. The corridor also provides important migration habitat for canvasback, scaup, redheads, mallards, American black ducks and others. In addition, grassland dependent neotropical songbirds such as Henslow's sparrows, bobolinks, sedge wrens, and eastern meadowlarks benefit from prairie protected or restored under this project.
