TOTAL ACRES

Ohio has 34 NAWCA projects either completed or underway. These projects have conserved 28,385 acres of wildlife habitat. NAWCA funding of more than \$9.5 million stimulated partner contributions of over \$33.6 million. These figures do not include multi-state projects.

NORTHEASTERN OHIO WETLANDS PROJECT

This project addresses a critical need to conserve wetland habit in northeastern Ohio. Situated on the southern shore of Lake Erie, this area provides critical migration stopover and breeding habitat to an array of waterfowl and migratory birds. The primary goal of the project is to permanently protect emergent, forested and scrub-shrub wetlands, riparian areas and associated uplands on targeted tracts to benefit waterfowl and other migratory birds in areas vulnerable to urbanization.

The secondary goal is to restore wetland habitats on private lands to provide connections among permanently protected areas. The project areas provide nesting, brood rearing, migration stopover and wintering habitat for several waterfowl species, wetland-dependent species and birds, such as American black ducks, wood ducks, American and least bitterns and king and Virginia rails.
