*Wyoming has 10 NAWCA projects either completed or underway. These projects have conserved 46,660 acres of wildlife habitat. NAWCA funding of more than \$1.5 million partner contributions of over \$3.7 million. These figures do not include multi-state projects.*

## OCEAN LAKE WETLANDS

This project will help the grantee achieve four objectives, hydrologic control of the wetlands in the complex, create appropriate plant community composition and structure, expand the area and diversity of wetland types on the property and improved water quality.

Because hydrology is the principal ecological driver of wetland habitat condition, recreational opportunity and management cost and its control is key to effective wetland management. This project will identify and procure enough water to supply the wetlands during all critical periods over a given year.

This includes supplies for wetland inundation during the spring migration, for irrigation during the growing season and for inundation during the fall and winter hunting seasons. Procurement of water for the wetland will be accomplished through the rehabilitation of existing irrigation infrastructure and through the development of new surface and ground water diversions on the tract. This project is designed to provide optimal foraging habitat for nonbreeding populations of waterfowl including northern pintail, mallard and American wigeon.
