TOTAL ACRES

Ohio has 42 NAWCA projects either completed or underway. These projects have conserved 31,366 acres of wildlife habitat. NAWCA funding of more than \$11 million stimulated partner contributions of over \$42.1 million. These figures do not include multi-state projects.

LAKE ERIE COASTAL WETLANDS III

The primary goal of this project is the permanent protection of forested, emergent, and scrub-shrub wetlands, riparian areas, and associated forested uplands on seven targeted land tracts to benefit waterfowl and other migratory birds in areas vulnerable to urbanization. The secondary goal of this proposal is to restore wetland habitats on private lands to provide habitat connections between permanently protected areas and offer additional waterfowl breeding and spring migration habitat in this fragmented landscape. Benefitted species include American Black Ducks, Wood Ducks, American Bitterns, King Rails, American Woodcock and Wilson's Snipe.

This third phase of the project will permanently protect 1,895 of these acres through fee-title acquisition of seventeen tracts and by purchasing a conservation easement on another tract. This project will also restore 100 acres of wetlands and 25 acres of associated uplands and enhance 70 acres of wetlands.
