*Rhode Island has 11 NAWCA projects either completed or underway. These projects have conserved 5,733 acres of wildlife habitat. NAWCA funding of more than \$6.6 million stimulated partner contributions of over \$31.6 million.*

## WETLAND REST. ON THREE NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGES & ADJACENT LAND PHASE I

At the Rhode Island National Wildlife Refuge (NWR) Complex, project partners will control common reed, an invasive plant species considered to be the highest management priority of all invasive plants. Its ability to establish itself easily, reproduce prolifically, and disperse readily makes eradication costly, labor-intensive, and difficult. It quickly displaces native communities by out-competing them for sunlight, water and nutrients.

Previous eradication efforts at Trustom Pond NWR, one of the complex's five refuges, resulted in a 90 percent decrease in common reed. In this project's first phase, partners will continue eradication efforts at this refuge on adjacent private lands and to the Ninigret NWR. Partners will assess the reed situation at John H. Chafee NWR. In total, reed control will help restore habitat on 52 acres of protected coastal wetlands. The project lands are in the Atlantic Coast Joint Venture's Coastal Ponds Focus Area, as well as its Ninigret Pond and Trustom Pond area.
