

USDA APHIS REVISED CONDITIONS FOR IMPORTATION OF HUNTER-HARVESTED WILD GAME BIRDS FROM CANADA Effective August 3, 2023

Unprocessed hunter-harvested wild game bird carcasses originating or transiting Canada must meet the following conditions:

- Viscera, head, neck, feet, and 1 wing removed; an
- Feathers removed, except 1 wing, as required by U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service for species identification; and
- Carcasses rinsed in fresh, clean water; no visible evidence of contamination with dirt, blood, feces; and
- Carcasses imported in sealed, leak-proof plastic packaging, thoroughly cleaned on the outside, and stored in leak-proof container during transport; and
- Carcasses chilled or frozen during transport and import
