


# Hawai'i's City of Refuge Tour

In ancient times, defeated warriors and kapu-breakers, (code of conduct breakers), could escape death if they were able to reach this sacred refuge. Here you will learn about life in Hawai'i before outsiders came to the island in the late 1700s. A National Park, these well-preserved grounds have statues of ancient gods, community structures and the sacred Hale-o-Keawe Heiau. Situated on a beautiful beach, the City of Refuge is a well preserved snapshot into the daily life of these early Hawai'ian people.




