





### CONVENTION GUN

CEO Dale Hall earned the respect of DU volunteers and staff by acknowledging their exemplary efforts with the presentation of a specially made belt buckle. The decision to award a buckle was entirely Dale's and each recipient was honored



to be recognized by DU's CEO. To commemorate this tradition, Ducks Unlimited designed a Browning Citori Grand Lightning 20 gauge over/under shotgun which compliments Dale's Buckles. The nickel-plated receiver features deep-relief engraving and the DU logo on both sides. The 26" barrels are polished blue, and the grade V/VI gloss finished walnut stock has a round knob grip. The bottom of the receiver notes that this shotgun is number one of only two guns created and the inscription reads, 'A Special Thanks from Ducks Unlimited'.

### BROWNING AUTO-5 SWEET 16



Few shotguns, if any, carry the esteem of the iconic Browning Auto-5. In 1988, Ducks Unlimited commissioned Browning to produce an Auto-5 Sweet 16 as its gun of the year. Several unique features make this gun stand out in a crowd. The wood on this particular line of shotguns is of very high quality. Browning claims that it is grade III, however, collectors will be hard pressed to find grade III walnut that is anywhere near as figured as the wood on this shotgun. The metal is deeply engraved with waterfowl scenes on both sides of the receiver and the metal finish is categorized as French Gray- an elegant and rarely used tone that underscores class and discernment for conscientious buyers. Finally, the 26" barrel has an Invector choke system. This feature makes this Auto-5 one of the rarest around, as most Sweet 16 shotguns came with a fixed choke. This Auto-5 is bound to be a prized possession in your gun safe or duck blind.


