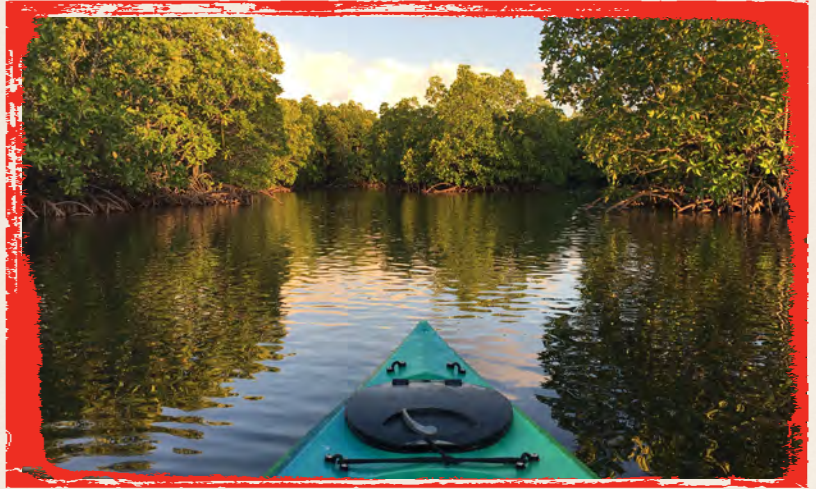
KAYAKING AND BIRDWATCHING IN MANGROVE FOREST

Nestled along Florida's Gulf Coast is a vibrant ecosystem rich in biodiversity. Enjoy your day as you are guided through the mangrove forest and tunnels of the Suncoast Youth Conservation Center. A partnership between the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, Tampa Electric Company, the University of Florida, and The Florida Aquarium, this campus was established as an educational center for youth and families. Expect to see

a wide variety of birds and wildlife. This rich and healthy ecosystem is also home to manatees during cooler weather. After your journey through the mangroves, you will have time to visit the Sea Turtle Rehabilitation Center. *For those who don't want to paddle but still want to experience nature, we will have a naturalist guide you through the mangroves on the walking paths.* Lunch will be provided. Kayaking space is limited. Sign up early. *For those kayaking, please wear loose-fitting clothes that can get wet. Closed toe and closed heel shoes that can get wet are required.

Explore the historic district of Ybor City, a neighborhood with a history deeply rooted in cigars and a home to immigrants from Spain, Cuba, and Italy. With a need for highly skilled labor, the Ybor City cigar companies created a community where laborers could purchase small houses, enjoy a rich social life centered around social clubs, and receive cradle-to-grave healthcare. Cigar City changed the entire world. Enter buildings preserved in time that only this tour has access to. Hear the stories of the immigrants who built social clubs of ornate stature to show off their

culture and celebrate their traditions. Then, step foot on Cuban-owned land where Cuban patriot José Martí sparked his revolution. *This is a walking tour. There will be some uneven pavement.
